Kisco Information Systems Moves Operations to Saranac Lake

Saranac Lake, NY, March 26, 2002: Kisco Information Systems (www.kisco.com) today announced that it is moving its headquarters from Mount Kisco, New York to Saranac Lake.

Kisco's profitable but lesser known iSeries-AS/400 professional services business has been spun off, and the company will now focus solely on providing system security software solutions and other utilities. In the past five years, Kisco has launched strategic security products, which have greatly expanded their software business. Because Kisco will no longer be providing professional services and facilities management services to companies in the metropolitan area, their proximity to New York City is less important and the option to move to away from the city is more viable.

Saranac Lake, situated in the Adirondack Mountains near Lake Placid, is 280 miles north of Mount Kisco, which is just outside of New York City.

Although a five-hour commute is more than most people would deem acceptable, Kisco will continue to be staffed with the same key technical and marketing people. "We have managed our business very well with professionals who telecommute, even before many of the tools to facilitate this evolved and it became mainstream," states Rich Loeber, President of Kisco Information Systems. "Having decentralized technical and sales resources will not represent a change for us whatsoever."

The facility that Kisco is relocating to has important historical significance. The Saranac Laboratory was key in the search for a cure for Tuberculosis, at a time when the country was besieged by the disease. Dr. Edward Livingston Trudeau, a pioneer in Tuberculosis research, built the facility in 1894. It was the first laboratory in the United States built for the study of the disease. For almost seventy years, research was conducted at Saranac Laboratory on this illness and others, such as the effects of asbestos inhalation. In February of 2000, New York state governor George Pataki allocated funds for the facility's rehabilitation due to its historical significance to the nation and the northern region of New York State.

Kisco's new address is 7 Church Street, Saranac Lake, New York, 12982. Their telephone number has changed to (518) 897-5002. Kisco will announce an open house shortly after the move is completed.
